

I. Possible Stipend Sources (Include but not Exclusive):

(A) NTU Stipend for New Faculty

- must meet one of the following criteria:
 - (1) Have not held or do not hold a full-time teaching or research position within the establishment of a domestic academic research institution.
 - (2) Have worked at a foreign academic research institution for the past five years before the day of application.
- For Professor, NT\$80,000 per month (USD 34K annually)
For Associate Professor, NT\$60,000 per month (USD 26K annually)
For Assistant Professor, NT\$30,000 per month (USD 13K annually)

(B) MOE Grant for the Jade Mountain (YuShan) Young Scholar Program

- Applicants must meet one of the following requirements:
 - (1) Has worked at a leading international research institution or an international renowned company for at least 5 years and has potential development.
 - (2) Has experience in conducting major research projects.
 - (3) Has made an exceptional contribution to the area of his or her academic expertise during the past 5 years.
- Yushan young scholars may receive nonstatutory salary of no more than NT\$1.5 million(USD 54K) annually(the nonstatutory salary can be approved once for 5 years) and an administration and operation fees of no more than NT\$1.5 million(USD 54K), which can be approved once for 5 years.

(C) MOE Grant for the Jade Mountain (YuShan) Scholar Program

- Applicants must meet one of the following requirements:
 - (1) Has worked at a leading international research institution, an internationally renowned company for at least 10 years, has an international academic reputation or international cutting-edge expertise in a core technology, and has experience in leading an academic or industrial research team.
 - (2) Has been awarded the Nobel Prize, is a fellow of a national-level academy, is a fellow of a major international association, or has received some equivalent recognition.
 - (3) Has made an outstanding contribution to the area of his or her academic expertise during the past 5 years.
- Yushan scholars may receive nonstatutory salary of no more than NT\$5 million(USD 180K) annually (the nonstatutory salary can be approved once for 3 years) and an administration and operation fees of no more than NT\$1.5 million(USD 54K), which can be approved once for 3 years.

II. Possible Research Funding Sources (Include but not Exclusive):

In addition to the regular Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST) grants, other possible grant types are also available:

(A) MOST Grant for the Emerging Young Scholars (2030 Cross-Generation Young Scholar Program)

- Have worked in full-time teaching or research positions domestically or overseas within 5 years prior to applying or have acquired a PhD degree within 5 years prior to applying.
- A maximum of 25 new projects may be approved and subsidized annually unless otherwise specified, and each project shall be subsidized by no more than NT\$5 million (USD 180K) per year.

(B) MOST Grant for the Excellent Young Scholars (2030 Cross-Generation Young Scholar Program)

- Applicants must not be older than 45 years of age and be qualified to act as principal investigators for MOST Research Project Grants.
- Approval of the number of new projects per year and the annual subsidy for each project are prioritized on the basis of review outcomes

(C) MOST Grant for the International Outstanding Young Scholars (2030 Cross-Generation Young Scholar Program)

- Applicants must be no older than 45 years of age and possess credentials in independent domestic and overseas research as well as achievements related to international academia such as the establishment of international teams.
- A maximum of 15 new projects may be approved and subsidized each year unless otherwise specified, and each project shall be subsidized by no more than NT\$10 million (USD 360K) per year.

(D) Academic Research-Career Development Project (Sprout Research Projects)

- Applicants must be a full-time NTU faculty member and undertaking a MOST multi-year Special Topic Research Project and no older than 45 years of age.
- the amount granted depends on the nature and requirements of the research project proposed, subject to the conclusions of the proposal's review and the overall budget of the University
